- **Essential Duties and Responsibilities:**

Probationary police officers enforce all applicable laws of the United States, State of Indiana, and the ordinances and directives of the City of Tell City, IN; patrols all areas of the corporate limits of Tell City, IN; investigates traffic accidents and criminal activity; prepares detailed reports; responds to all police calls dispatched by communications; process and transport arrested suspects; perform rescue operations; maintain composure in emergency situations.

- **Minimum Qualification Requirements:**

- Applicant must be a resident citizen of the United States.
- Applicant must be at least 21 years of age and less than 36 years of age by time of appointment.
- Applicant must have high school diploma or GED.
- Applicant must possess a valid driver's license.
- Applicant must not have been convicted of a felony.
- Applicant must submit to a drug screen and background investigation.
- Applicant must successfully complete areas of the application process.
- Applicant must be able to meet and perform job duties outlined on job description.
