## TELL CITY TRASH DEPARTMENT PICK UP INFORMATION

City Trash picks up **EVERY WEEK**.

Trash needs to be set out in your designated trash area. If you have an alley, it is usually placed in the alley. If no through alley, it would be placed in front of residence at curb. Trash needs to be set out by 7:00 AM or night before to ensure pickup. A container is not required, unless you are in an area where animals tear up the bags.

The City charges a base rate of \$7.75 per month and RED City trash stickers are required to be placed on all bags. They are \$1.00 per tag and sold in a sheet of 5 for \$5.00. The Red Tell City trash stickers are sold at City Hall in the Utility Office, Walmart, Nobles and at both North and South On the Fly (Chuckles) Gas Stations.

If you place a bag for pick up without a red city sticker, the bag will be picked up and the resident will be charged \$5.00 per bag. Do not place trash bags in designated area for pickup if you do not want them picked up.

You can place as many bags as you like for pick up if they all have a red city sticker on them. Please follow the guidelines on placement of your sticker. The guidelines are printed on the sticker. Do not use half stickers on the bags as this will result in being charged \$5.00 per bag.

If you miss your trash pickup and have the means of transporting it to 1102 5<sup>th</sup> Street at the Street Dept. garage, TAGGED BAGS may be placed in their designated area **BEFORE 3:00 P.M.** on City workdays.

The City will have an annual Spring Clean Up in June. Residents are allowed to set out large items not normally picked up, during this time ONLY. The City will send out information cards out to each resident with information on the dates and what items that are allowed to be set out for pick up.

Recycling picks up **EVERY OTHER WEEK**. The schedule of the weeks of recycling is available at the Tell City Water, Sewage and Trash office. Attached is a copy of the recycling guidelines and what the city will pick up.

Please note that the Tell City Water, Sewage and Trash Department is not affiliated with the Perry County Recycling Management District annual fee of \$45.00. This is a county fee not a city fee. We do not accept payment for that service. That fee is payable at the Perry County Recycling Management District office located at 3214 Tell Street, Suite #4.
